

Refuse

When living in an apartment complex the disposal of waste can become a big issue. Please familiarise yourself with all the guidelines surrounding this. We are keen recyclers and there are many options for this. Disposal of any furniture items or large household items cannot be accommodated by our collection company. We do try to organise council pickups once or twice a year.

- Please note, ALL cardboard boxes – must be broken down / flattened and taken down to Lower Ground ‘Refuse Room’. Removalist boxes and large appliance packaging should be disposed of by you or your removalists as there will not be enough bin space to accommodate this with the amount of move ins we will have
- Recycling items must not be bagged as any non-recyclable plastic placed in yellow bins will result in the bin being rejected by collectors.
- Glass items must be taken down to the Lower Ground ‘Refuse Rooms’, not put down chutes (bottles – jars etc)
- DO NOT clog the chutes with oversized rubbish / boxes
- Please BAG all Refuse / General Waste (preferably double bagged)
- If in doubt, put rubbish down the Refuse / General Waste chute or bin in the Lower Ground Refuse Room.
- Animal waste must be double-bagged and put in General Waste bins in main bin rooms (not down chutes)
- Green Waste – to go in red bins or in the green waste skip on the loading dock
- Special Containers for Change bins – located in main refuse rooms
Battery recycling bin located in main refuse room A (buildings 1-2)
E-waste (small items only) located in main refuse rooms A & B (buildings 1-2/3-4)
